Preparing for storms.....

With Spring storms pending, it is important we are prepared. Even though we have storm sirens, it is a good idea to have a weather radio to alert you to any weather advisories and warnings.

A weather radio has a battery backup so if you lose electricity (no tv or internet) you will have your warning system in place.

You can purchase a weather radio at Walgreens, Wal-Mart, and other similar locations.

If you are able to, it is good to install a tornado shelter at your location.

If your shelter is installed underground, please contact City Hall and give us your location so we can add you to the list of areas to check after a weather event has occurred.
